GENERAL NEWS**AMRITANANDAMAYI MUTT CONDUCTS MASSIVE HEALTH CAMP**

Mysore, Mar. 21 (RR&NMG)- A massive free health check-up, in memory late S. Suvama, founder of Deepa House Building Co-operative Society, on his death anniversary, was inaugurated this morning at Amrita Kripa Charitable Hospital in Roopnagar here by the City Police Commissioner Praveen Sood.

The camp was organised by Mata Amritanandamayi Mutt, Bogadi, in association with Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS), Kochin, Kerala.

The camp provided tests for diabetes, heart problems, health of women and children with the help of a satellite-linked Tele-medicine unit.

Advocate O. Shama Bhat, Hon. Advisor of the Mutt, in his welcome address recalled that though late Suvama wanted to build a charitable hospital at Roopnagar as a joint venture with Mata Amritanandamayi Mission, donated the proposed land to the Mission to construct an independent hospital after he visited AIMS.

Praveen Sood, in his inaugural address opined that, the religious organisations are playing a major role in providing medical services to the needy and if they withdraw their service activities, the situation for the commonman will become miserable.

He lauded late Suvama for his gesture of providing land for Amrita Kripa Charitable Hospital.

Senior doctors from city Dr. Ranganathaiah, Paediatrician Dr. Vamanarao Bapat, Dr. Ramesh and about ten doctors from AIMS participated in the camp.

Amritakripananda Puri, a senior desciple of Mata Amritanandamayi was present. Amrita Mahavidyalaya students Neetu Krishnan and Lidia rendered invocation. More than 500 persons underwent medical examination in the camp.

Achutha Pai, General Manager (retd.), Corporation Bank, will unveil the bust of S. Suvama at the Deepa School premises in Roopnagar today at 5 pm.

Mysore, Mar. 21 (RR& NMG)- Dr. Santhosh Pai, in-charge of the Telemedicine Unit from AIMS, Kochin, who spoke to Star of Mysore said that the satellite-linked Telemedicine system has changed the adage "Doctor at your doorstep" into "Hospital at your doorstep".

He disclosed that the unit is capable of conducting ECG, Echo, Chest X-ray, Ultra Sound Probe, Cardiology and various other life saving tests and transfer the data to AIMS where it is processed and the necessary advice provided through the unit in a matter of minutes.

This will be vital in saving lives in accidents, heart attacks and other emergencies, he said.
