Fellowship in Gastrointestinal and Pancreatic Pathology (FGIPP) **at Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Center, Kochi**

- 🔬 One year Fellowship program aimed to provide a comprehensive understanding of the spectrum of neoplastic and non-neoplastic diseases that primarily or secondarily affect the gastrointestinal tract and pancreas in both adult and paediatric patients.
- 🔬 This program provides exposure to transplant pathology (Endoscopic biopsies in the context of hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, renal transplant, small bowel allograft biopsies /resection)
- 🔬 The course will help to gain experience in ultrasound guided fine needle aspiration cytology of GIT, especially pancreas.
- 🔬 The Gastrointestinal pathology fellow will engage in both independent and collaborative research.

Course starting in February 2016

Eligibility Criteria

Essential: Post-graduate training in Pathology (MD / DNB).

Candidates with MCI recognized foreign qualification(s) are also eligible to apply.

Desirable: Demonstration of interest in Gastrointestinal Pathology; published work in the area.

Duration of Program: 12 months
