CALL FOR APPLICANTS AND NOMINATION

To comply with the Erasmus+ Program rules, it is necessary you send us the text of the call for applicants (or a summary in English) and/or the link to the website where it has been published. When you complete the selection process, please send us the formal nomination through a signed document, with deadline of September 25th for spring semester and 15th April for autumn semester.

Attached you can find a template as an example.

Due to the large number of expected mobilities for spring semester 2020-21, If possible, we would be grateful if you could consider distributing the assigned number of mobilities for the three remaining semesters of the project.

GENERAL

We strongly recommend all candidates should have at least Spanish A1 level, this will allow them to obtain better benefit from their stay and they will be admitted at the Spanish A2 level courses.

Please take into account that admission at the School of Business IS VERY UNLIKELY. See other course restrictions in doc attached.

The minimum of ECTS is 30, and research works can be included. The student shall take exams and get scores, which in the case, must be lately recognized at the home institution according the condition settled in the learning agreement.

The mobilities can be carried on during the Autumn semester (September-January) or Spring semester (January-June), the scholarship grants 5 months (850€/month) of stay + travel aid (see below EU travel distance band), and the student shall get a student visa for 6 months, so he/she can stay legally in Spain up to 6 months.

UNDERGRADUATE and MASTER STUDENTS:

Undergraduate candidates must be at least in the third year of grade and preferably in the fourth year at the time of stay.

Candidates for Master must be in the second year or 30 ECTS completed at the time of stay.

If the Undergraduate or Master candidates have a Spanish B2 level, they will be admitted in any School without restrictions.

If the Undergraduate or Master candidates do not have a Spanish B2 level and therefore they intend to study full time in English, we advise students to combine the 30 ECTS between regular subjects and their final degree or master's work.

Nominated candidates, who intend to develop a final research work at UPV, shall belong to the areas of study that were agreed in the inter-institutional agreement with each partner. In this way, UPV professors who are already working with researchers from your institution can collaborate with the final degree or master project.



PHD STUDENTS

Particularly PhD students will develop their research with the UPV professors who already have a previous academic collaboration with researchers from your institution, so it will allow strengthening the academic and scientific relation.

PhD students will need to have a letter of pre-admission from Professor UPV who will supervise their research before their nomination is admitted.

Language restrictions does not apply for PhD students but they must have English B2 Level at least.
