1. QUALIFYING AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- a) **Qualification:** A candidate, who holds M.D. / M.S. degree from a recognized Medical College included in the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and has obtained full registration for M.D./ M.S. either from the Medical Council of India or any of the State Medical Councils.
- b) **Eligibility Criteria:** NEET SS – 2021 qualified candidates who have been allotted to Amrita School of Medicine by the MCC, New Delhi are eligible to report for admissions for the academic year 2021-22.

Note: Stipend will be paid as per Government norms.

It is mandatory to submit copy of Aadhaar card and Pan card at the time of admission.

2. SELECTION

Selection is based on the rank obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) and counselling allotment by DGHS.

3. PROGRAM DETAILS

- **Duration of the program:** Three years from the dates of commencement of classes.
- **Curriculum:** As per the Syllabus approved by MCI and Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham.

4. IMPORTANT

The admission activities to Super Specialty Medical and Dental Courses is through the Admission Office presided by the Chairman – Admissions, Amrita Healthcare Campus, Kochi.

Management of the AMRITA VISHWA VIDYAPEETHAM reserves the right to change any of the conditions enumerated herein for the purpose of complying with any of the regulations of the University Grants Commission (UGC) or any other competent authorities.

Centralized Counselling is conducted by the Directorate General of Health Service (DGHS) / Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) / Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MOHFW), Government of India, New Delhi through MCC website www.mcc.nic.in.

NEET qualified candidates are advised to visit MCC website www.mcc.nic.in and Amrita website (<https://amrita.edu/admissions/health-sciences/>) regularly for latest notifications and updates regarding counselling and allotment, scheme of counselling, schedule of counselling etc. Candidates should

apply/register for online counselling through mcc.nic.in as per the notification of DGHS.

If a candidate has secured a seat in Amrita in any of the allotment rounds conducted by DGHS, then he/she is requested to report at Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi for undertaking admission procedure as per the “schedule of reporting” published in MCC website.

The allotted candidates are advised to check Amrita website (<https://amrita.edu/admissions/health-sciences/>) for details of admission and other instructions before reporting to the medical college.

5. SEAT CATEGORY

- General Category: As per the DGHS – MCC guidelines (www.mcc.nic.in)

6. PROXY REPORTING FOR ADMISSION

Reporting for admission by proxy is not permitted. Admission of the allotted candidates who do not report to the Admission Office, Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi shall stand cancelled.

In extremely exceptional cases, where the candidate is unable to report physically due to illness for attending admission procedure, Chairman – Admissions at his sole discretion may permit candidate's father, mother to attend counselling on behalf of the candidate on the basis of a written request. Also specific authorization from the candidate with relevant Medical Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon or a Clinical Associate Professor of a Medical College should be submitted at the time of reporting for admission.

7. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

- All admissions/allotments are subject to verification of the original certificates and documents submitted by the candidates. The decision of the Chairman - Admissions regarding the eligibility of applicants shall be final.
- If at any time before or after admission it is found that the candidate does not meet the eligibility requirement, seat will be denied to him/her. Therefore, it is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ensure that he/she meets all the eligibility requirements.
- At the time of reporting for Admission to Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi, candidates should be accompanied either by their parent or spouse and should produce the following documents / certificates in Original along with one set of photocopies.
 - a) Online Provisional Allotment letter from MCC (two copies)
 - b) NEET SS 2021 / NEET – DM/MCh Score Card (two copies)
 - c) NEET SS 2021 / NEET – DM/MCh Admit Card (two copies)
 - d) MBBS & MD/MS University Examination Mark list
 - e) MBBS & MD/MS Degree Certificate from the concerned university
 - f) Internship Completion Certificate (MBBS & MD/MS)

- g) Registration Certificate for MBBS and MD/MS after completion of internship
- h) A document to prove the Date of Birth (SSLC or Birth Certificate)
- i) Transfer Certificate & Character and Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied
- j) Migration certificate from the University from where the candidate secured last degree
- k) Relieving letter / NOC from the previous employer, whichever is applicable
- l) Two copies of Aadhaar Card and PAN Card of the candidate
- m) Recent passport size close-up color photographs of face - 8 nos
- n) Physically Handicapped Certificate (if applicable)
- o) Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- p) Medical Certificate for physical fitness and mental soundness from a medical officer (Government Hospital / Government Medical College) not below the rank of Civil Surgeon or a Clinical Associate Professor of a Medical College (as per the format prescribed in Amrita website)

(NOTE: 1) THE ABOVE CERTIFICATES IN ORIGINALS ARE MANDATORY.

9. FEE PAYMENT POLICY

- Candidates are requested to remit the first year fees at the time of admission as mentioned in the website: <https://amrita.edu/program/dm-mch/>
- From second year onwards tuition fees, other fees and hostel and mess fees should be paid within the stipulated date informed by the Academics Office.
- Failure to make the fee payment within the specified dates will turn to loss of attendance and also fine will be charged from the last day of fee remittance stipulated by the Institution. Fine

for general category is INR 500/- per day.

- d) Upon failure of fee payment, the stipend offered for PG Students will be withheld until all fee dues are cleared.
- e) A student will only be permitted to attend the University Examination after all fee dues are cleared.

10. ADMISSION CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS
